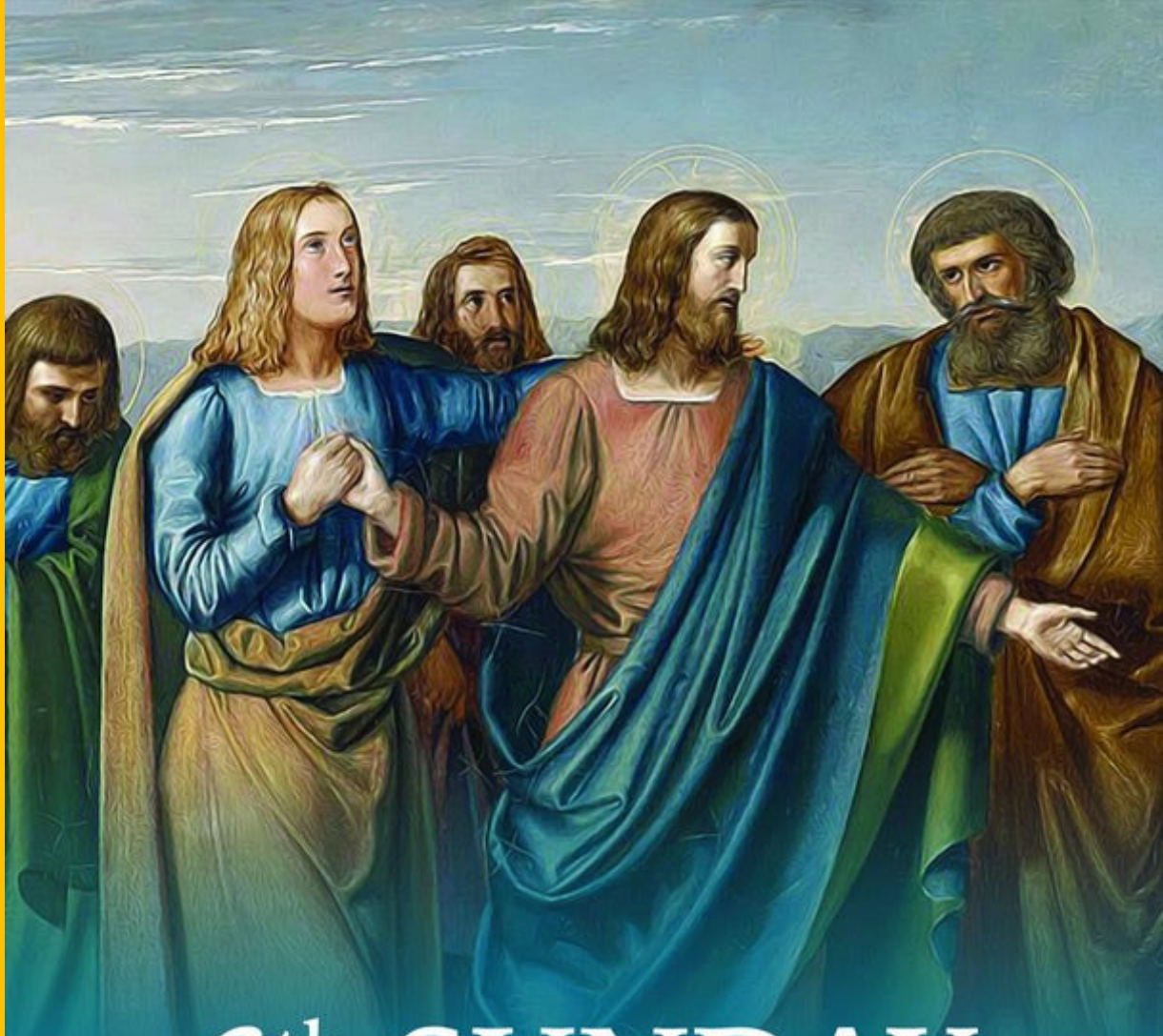




LITTLE CATHERINE PRAYED FOR THE SICK PEOPLE.

ON HER 16TH BIRTHDAY SHE MOVED TO QUEBEC, IN CANADA.


IT WASN'T AN EASY LIFE, BUT SHE LOVED THE NATIVE PEOPLE AND WAS ALWAYS CHEERFUL.

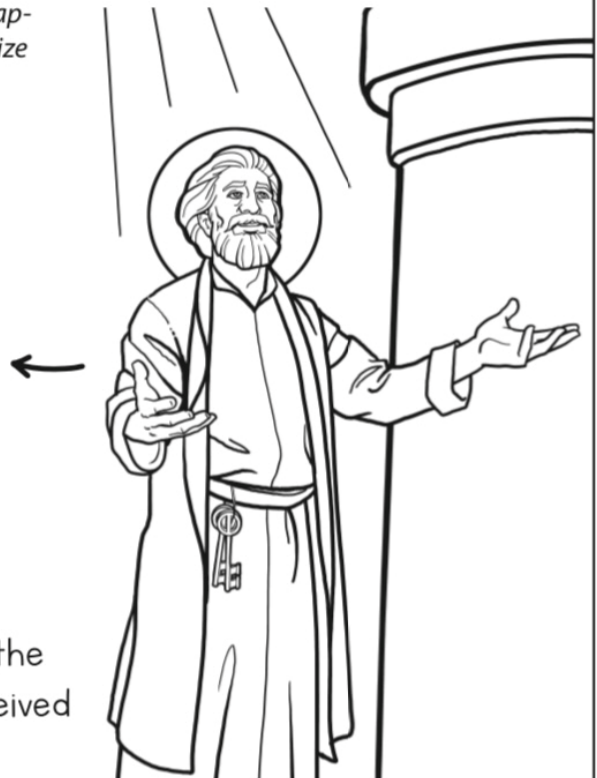
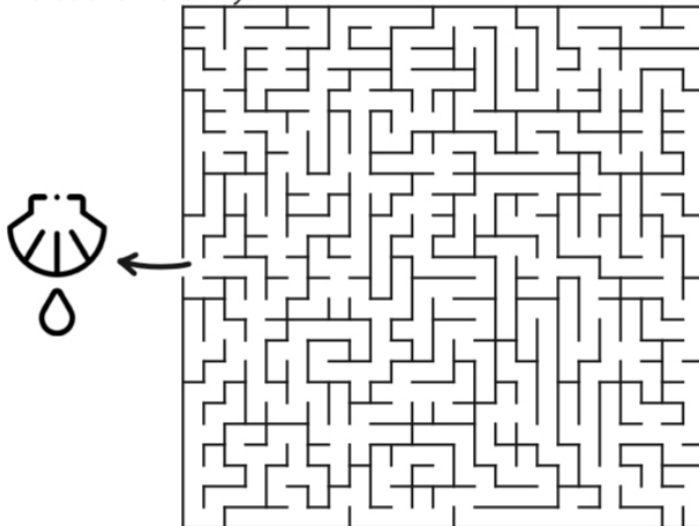
