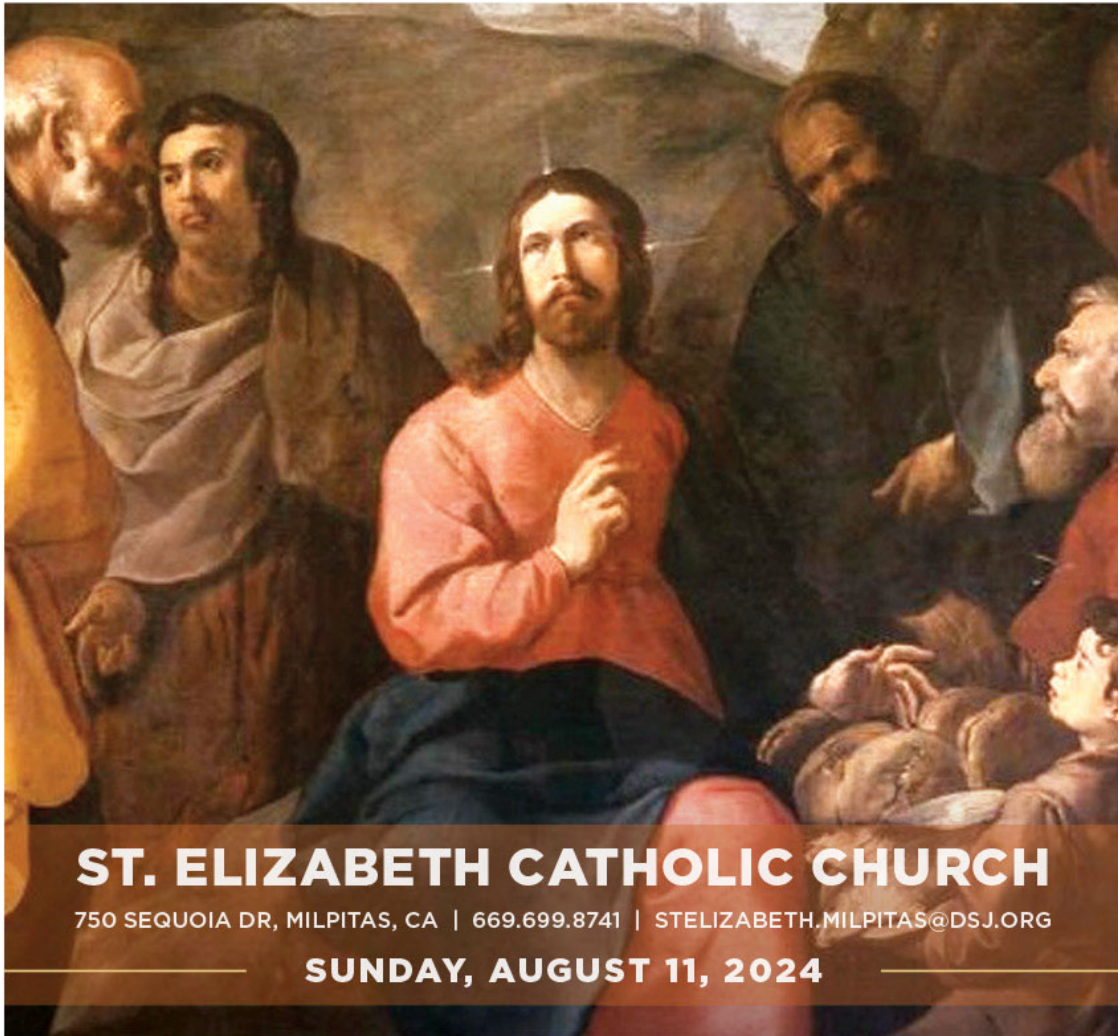

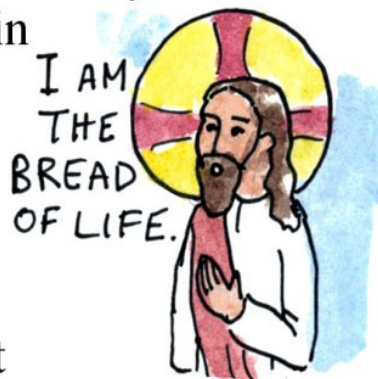
Believing in Jesus

HEAVEN...



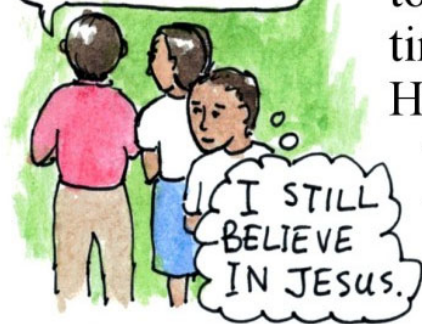

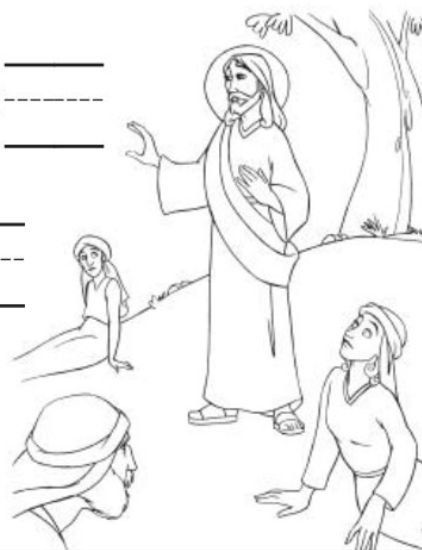
