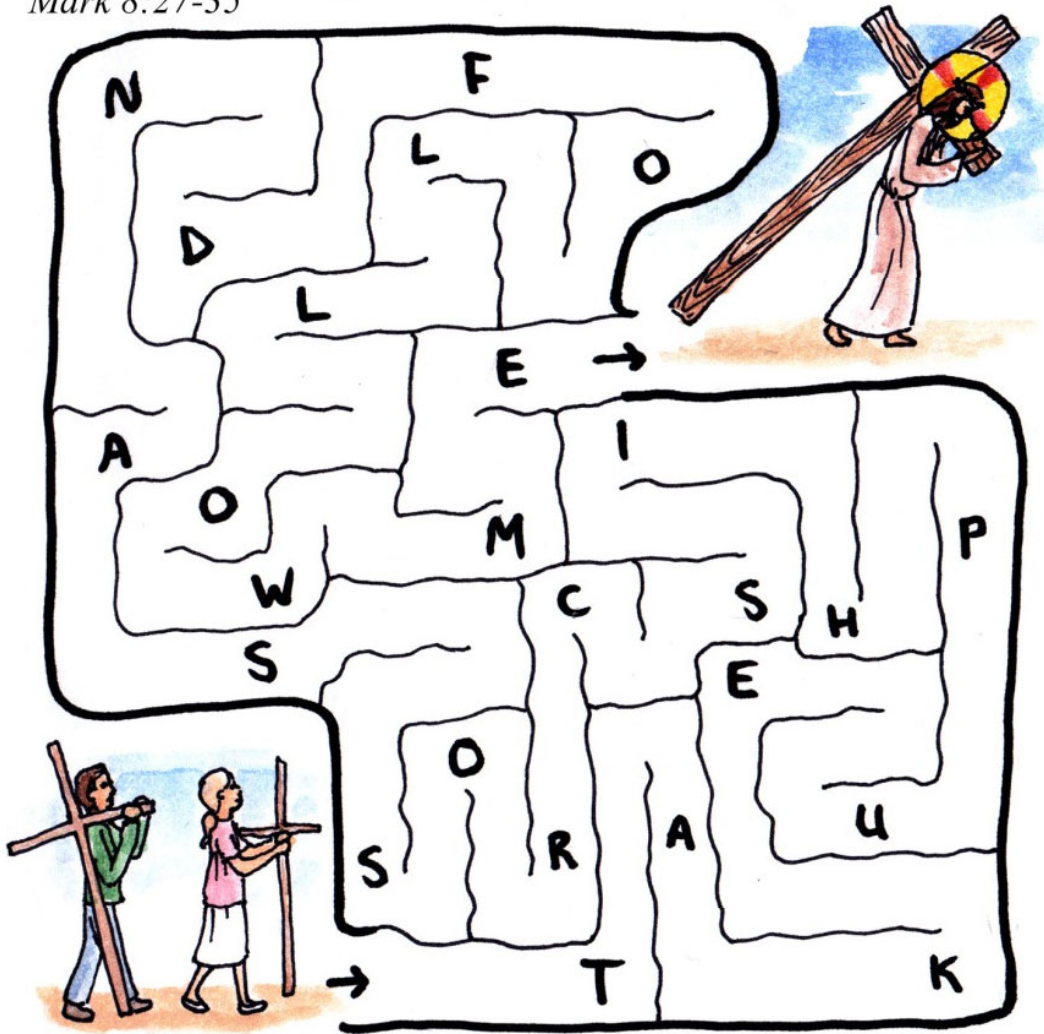

Saint Joseph of Cupertino




What are you doing, you foolish child? Come home at once!

FINALLY HIS MOTHER GOT HIM TO BECOME A SERVANT AT A FRANCISCAN MONASTERY.




You are only fit to be a servant!

Look how happy the donkey is!




JOSEPH BECAME HAPPY AS HE LOOKED AFTER THE DONKEY.

HE WAS ALLOWED TO BECOME A MONK, AND THEN A PRIEST, EVEN THOUGH HE COULD HARDLY STUDY.




I can't even read this!

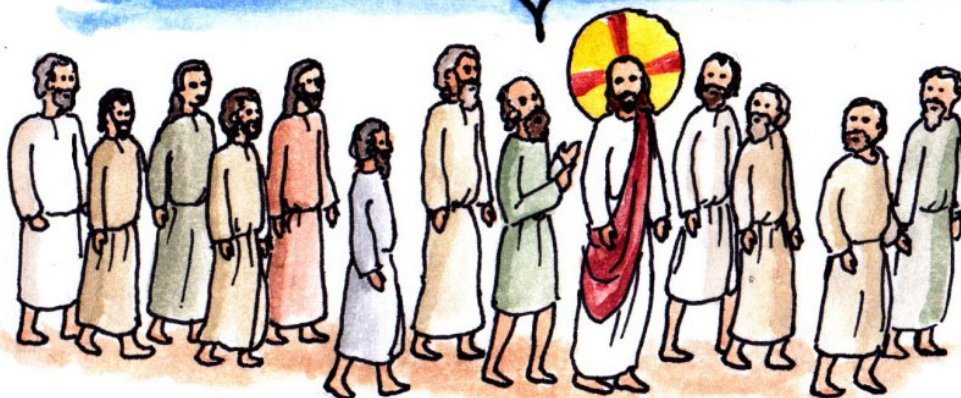

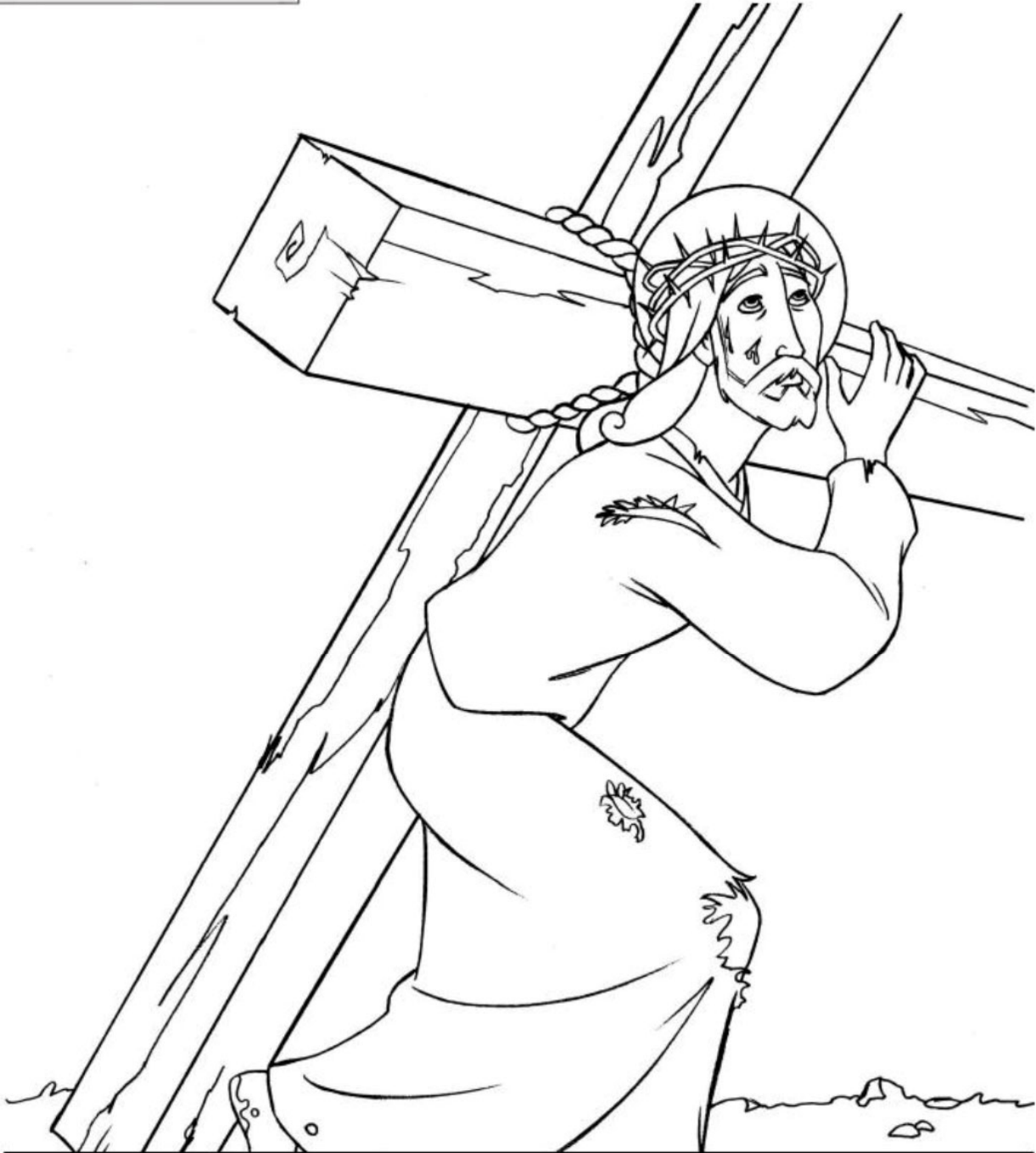
