



SAINTS COSMAS AND DAMIAN


SEPTEMBER 26




BOTH BROTHERS WERE VERY GOOD STUDENTS. THEY BECAME GREAT DOCTORS.




COSMAS AND DAMIAN WOULD NOT TAKE ANY PAY FOR THEIR WORK.



WHEN A PERSECUTION OF CHRISTIANS BEGAN THE BROTHERS WERE ARRESTED AND TORTURED.






