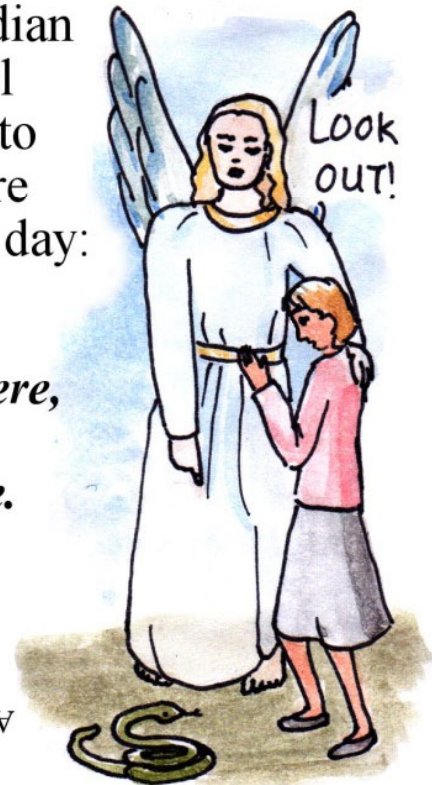

Amen.*

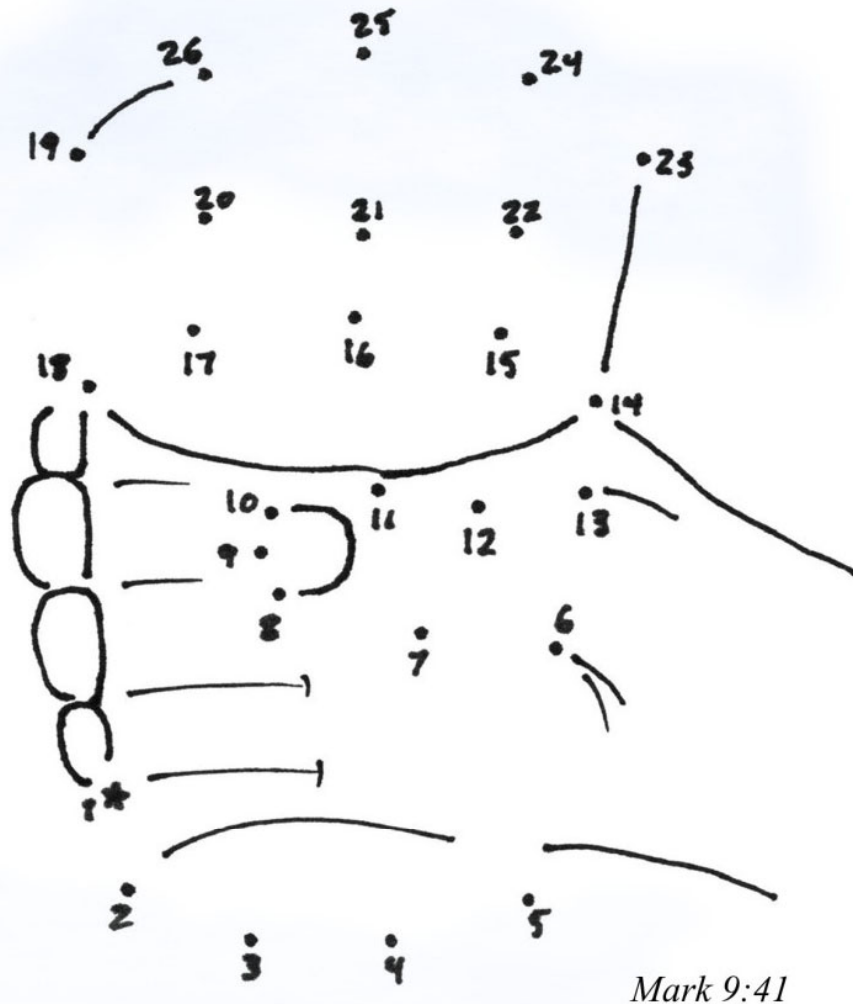

SHE WAS HUMBLE AND DID THE WORST JOBS AND ATE THE WORST FOOD FOR LOVE OF GOD.

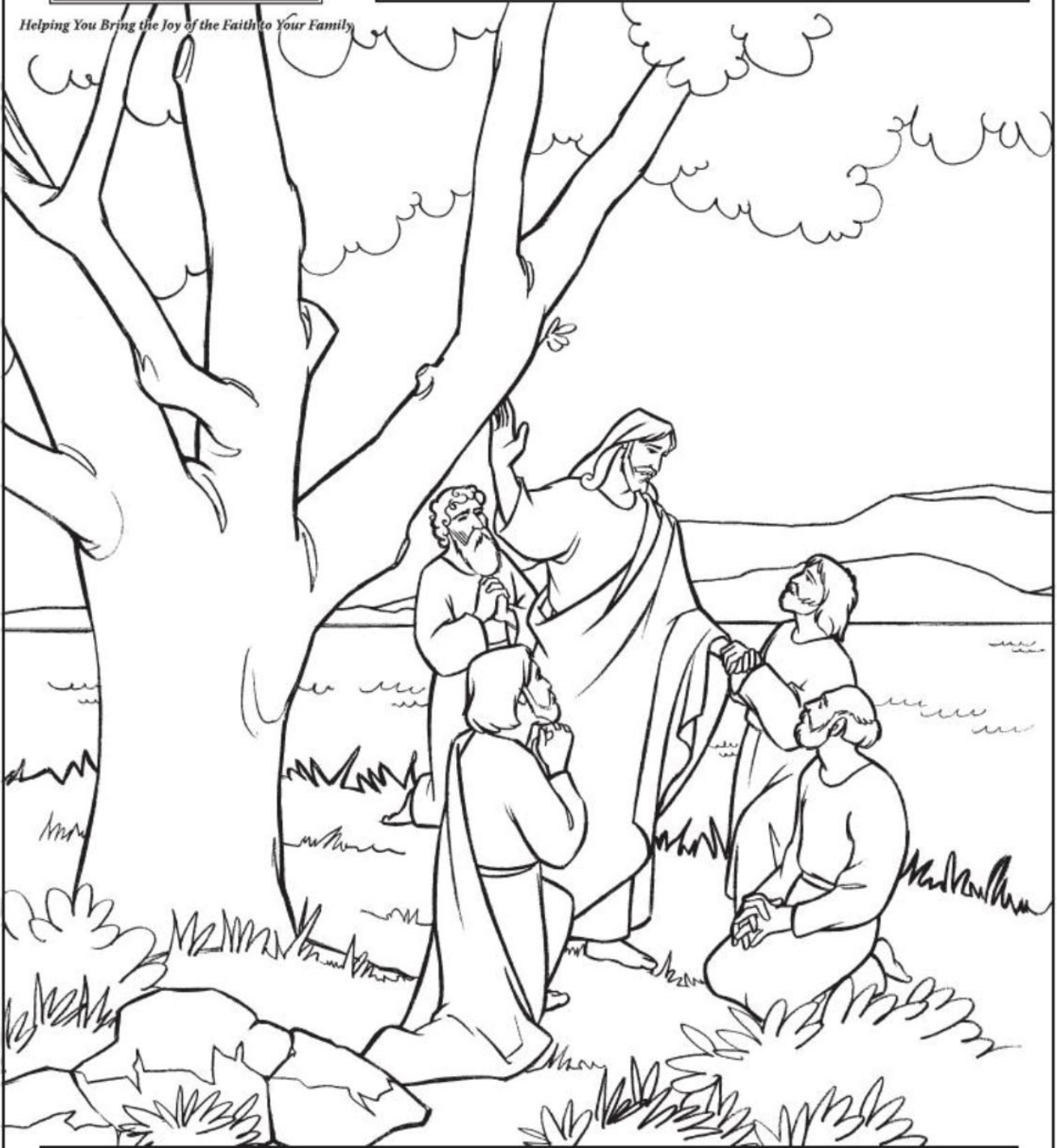
That stinks! Get it out of here!

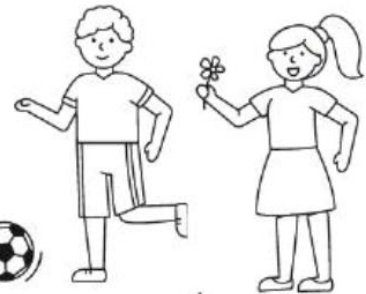

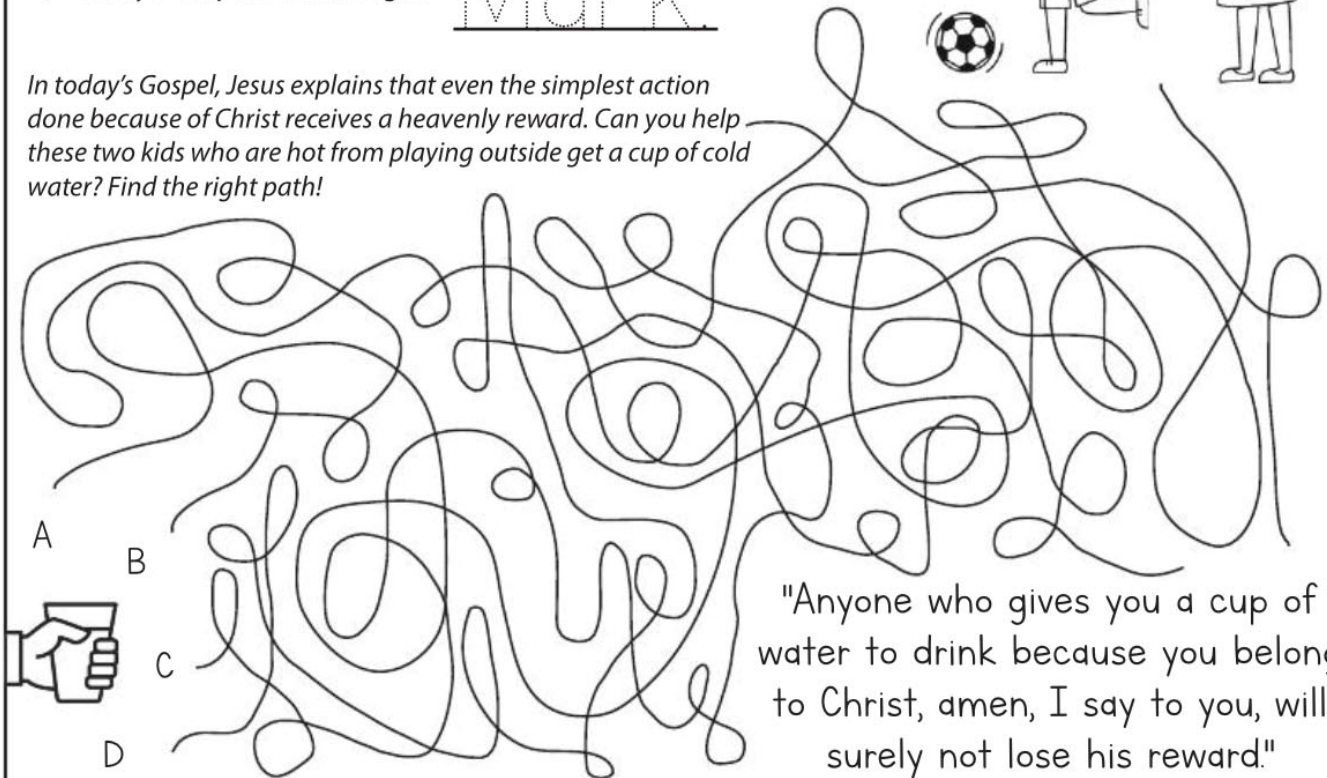
