I don't have time to pray...

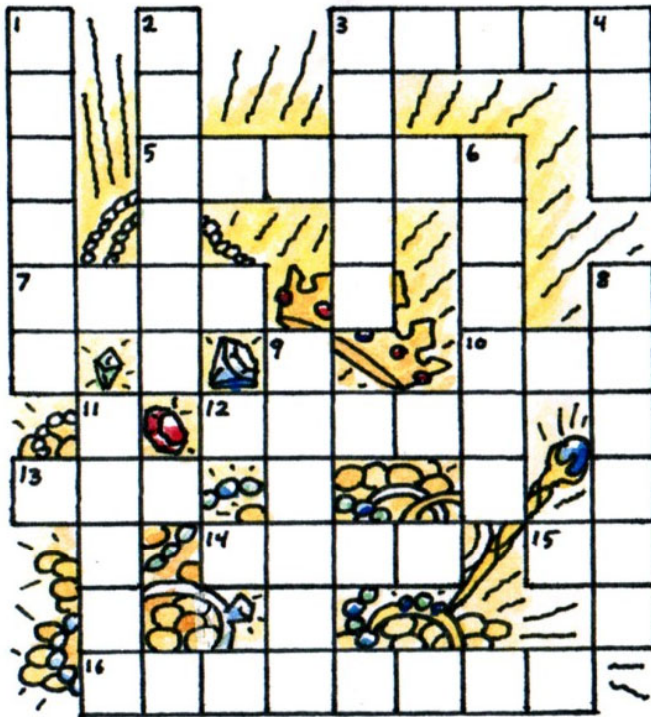
Did you hear about Elizabeth?

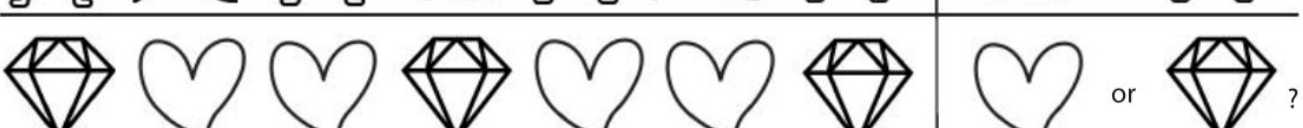
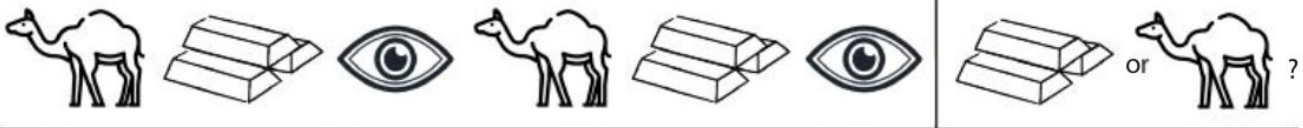
