

# ***Great People Serve Others!***


In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells us that the people who are really great are those who serve. Here are some really great people:

The pope has a very big job-looking after the whole Church. Did you know that the pope is called "The servant of the servants of God?" He is great because he is using his life to take care of God's people.


But who do you think is the best example of all? Jesus! He helped people all His life, and then He died so that everyone would have the chance to go to Heaven.
