Great People Serve Others!

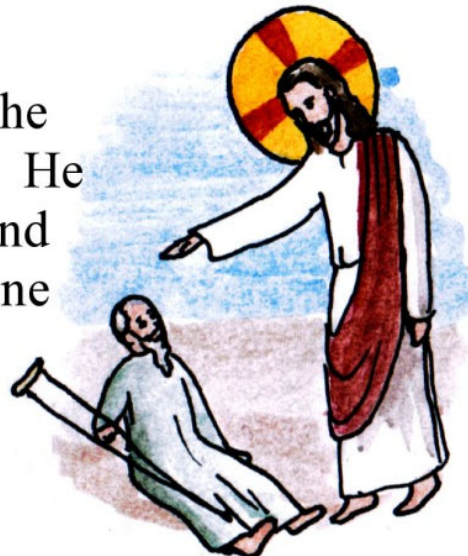
In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells us that the people who are really great are those who serve. Here are some really great people:

The pope has a very big job- looking after the whole Church. Did you know that the pope is called "The servant of the servants of God?" He is great because he is using his life to take care of God's people.

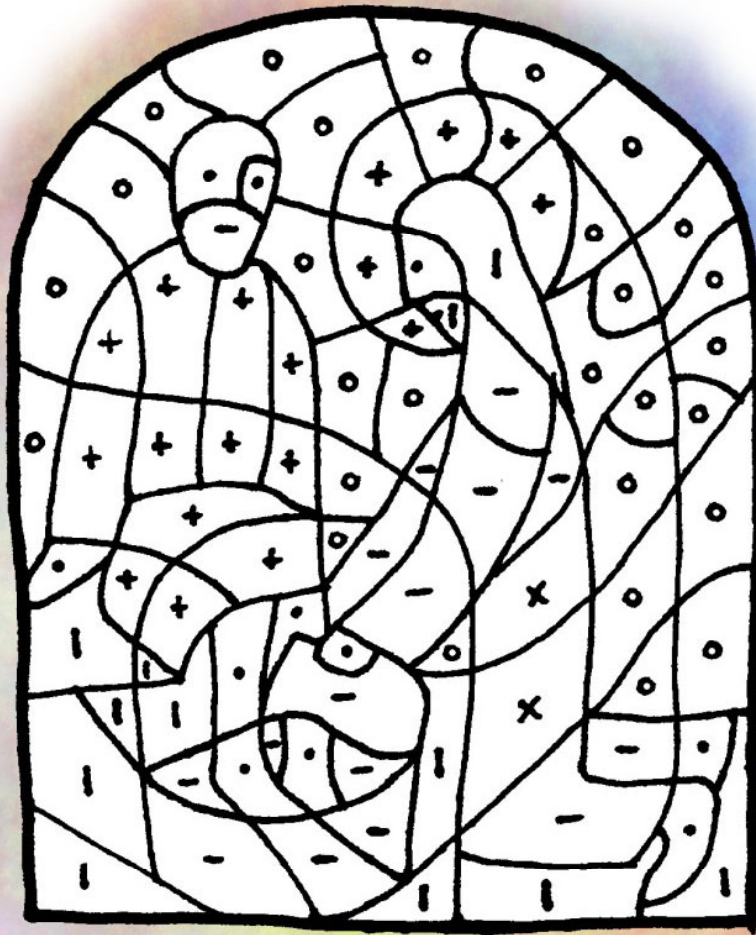
But who do you think is the best example of all? Jesus! He helped people all His life, and then He died so that everyone would have the chance to go to Heaven.






HE WAS ORDAINED AND SENT TO ROME TO STUDY FURTHER, AND THEN HE BECAME A PROFESSOR.




FR. WOJTYLA LOVED TEACHING THE YOUNG PEOPLE. SOON HE WAS ORDAINED A BISHOP.




HE WAS AT THE SECOND VATICAN COUNCIL, AND A FEW YEARS LATER WAS MADE A CARDINAL.




IN 1978 HE BECAME POPE JOHN PAUL II. HE WENT TO MANY COUNTRIES TO EVANGELIZE AND MAKE PEACE.



IN 1981 THE POPE WAS SHOT BY AN ASSASSIN BUT HE SURVIVED. MANY PEOPLE WERE PRAYING TO OUR LADY.



POPE JOHN PAUL WORKED FOR MANY YEARS TRYING TO BRING PEACE AND HOPE TO THE WORLD. EVEN WHEN HE WAS OLD AND SUFFERED FROM PARKINSON'S DISEASE. HE DIED ON APRIL 2, 2005.



SAINT JOHN PAUL GREW UP IN A TIME AND PLACE WHERE THERE WAS WAR ALL AROUND HIM. HE PRAYED AND WORKED TO BRING PEACE TO MANY NATIONS. WE SHOULD TRY TO BE PEACEFUL IN OUR FAMILIES AND SCHOOLS, AND PRAY FOR PEACE IN COUNTRIES WHERE PEOPLE ARE AT WAR.
