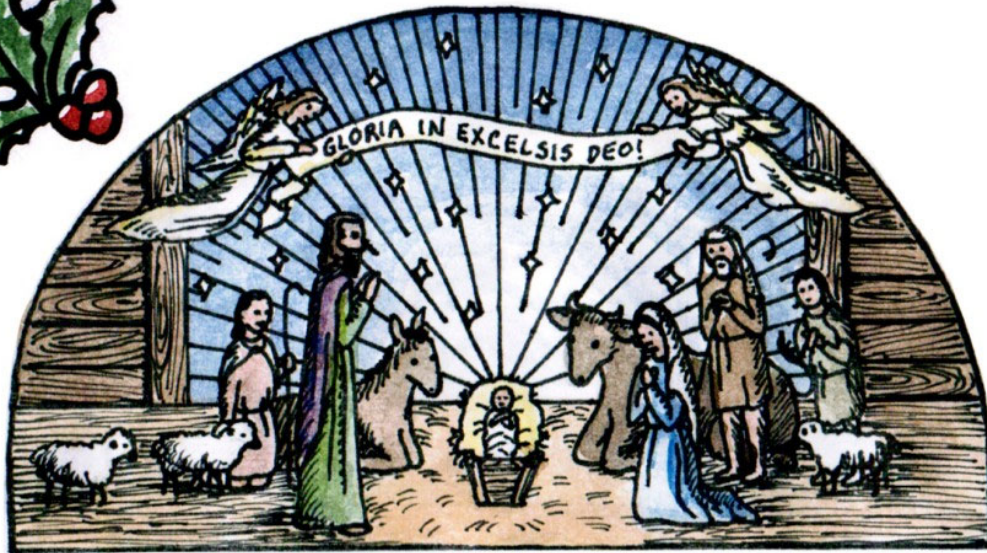


The Christmas Story



May it be done as you say!


God has chosen Mary...

THEY GOT MARRIED AND JOSEPH TOOK GOOD CARE OF MARY.






THEN THE EMPEROR SENT EVERYONE TO THEIR HOME TOWNS TO BE REGISTERED.

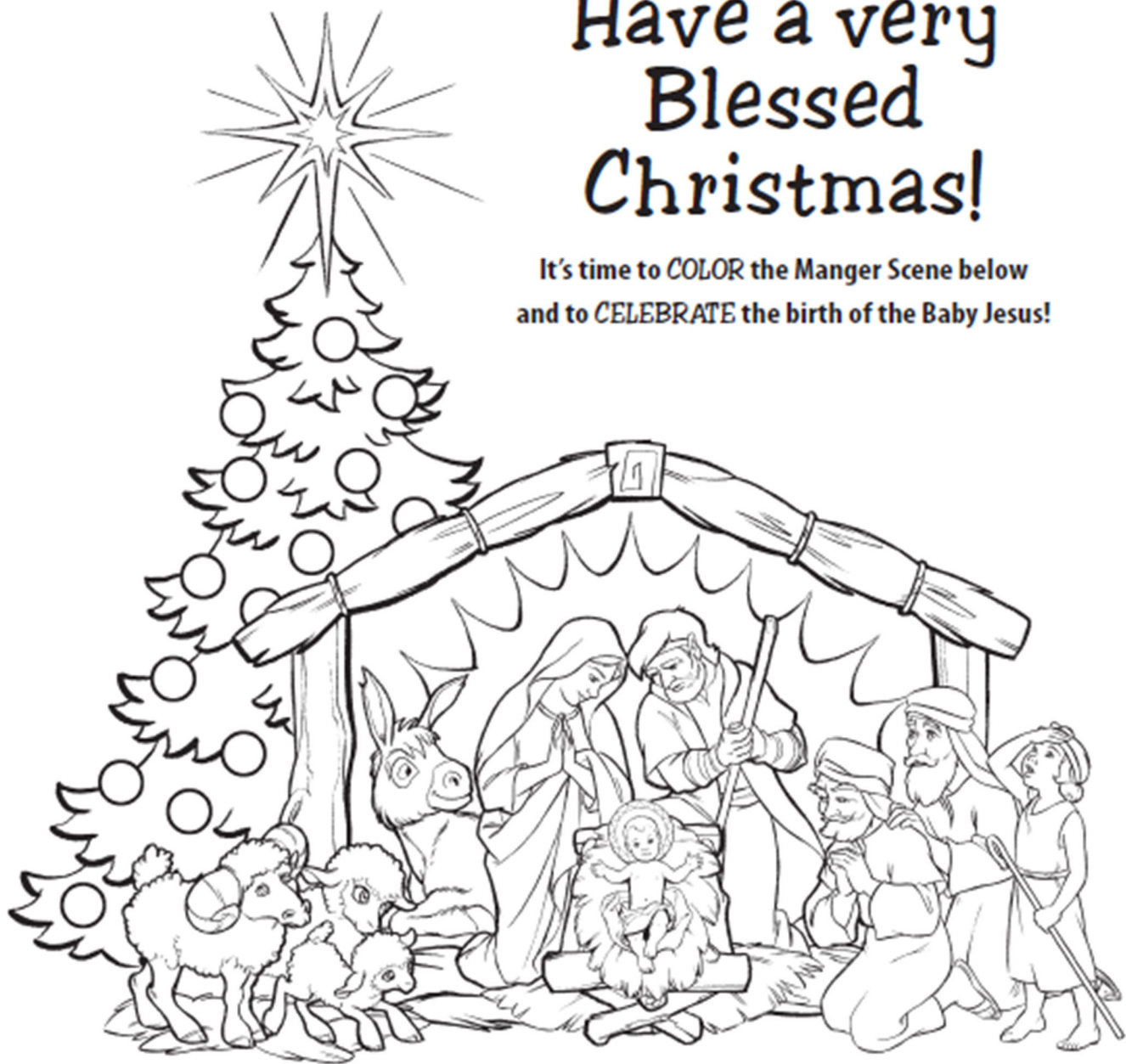

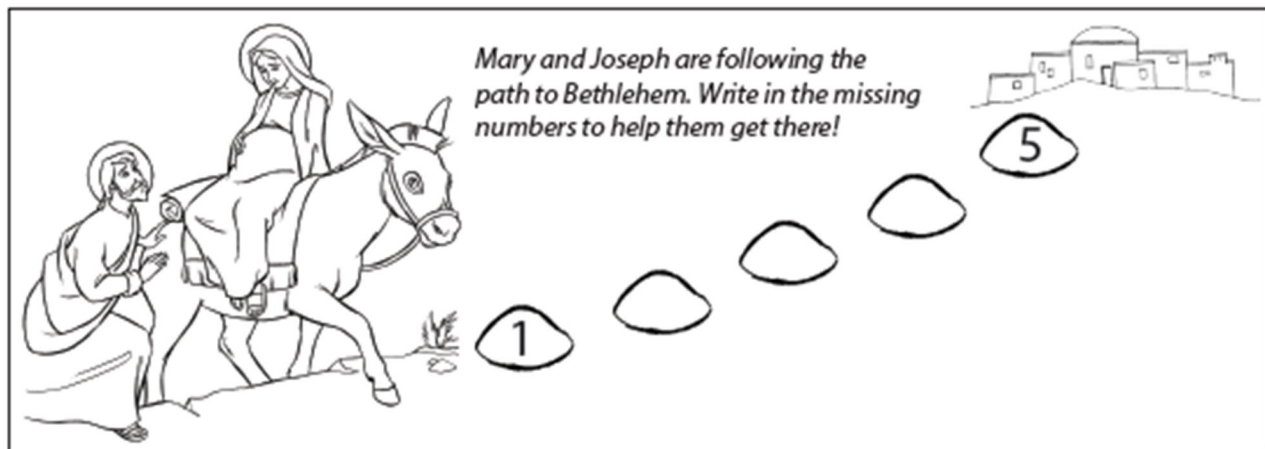
