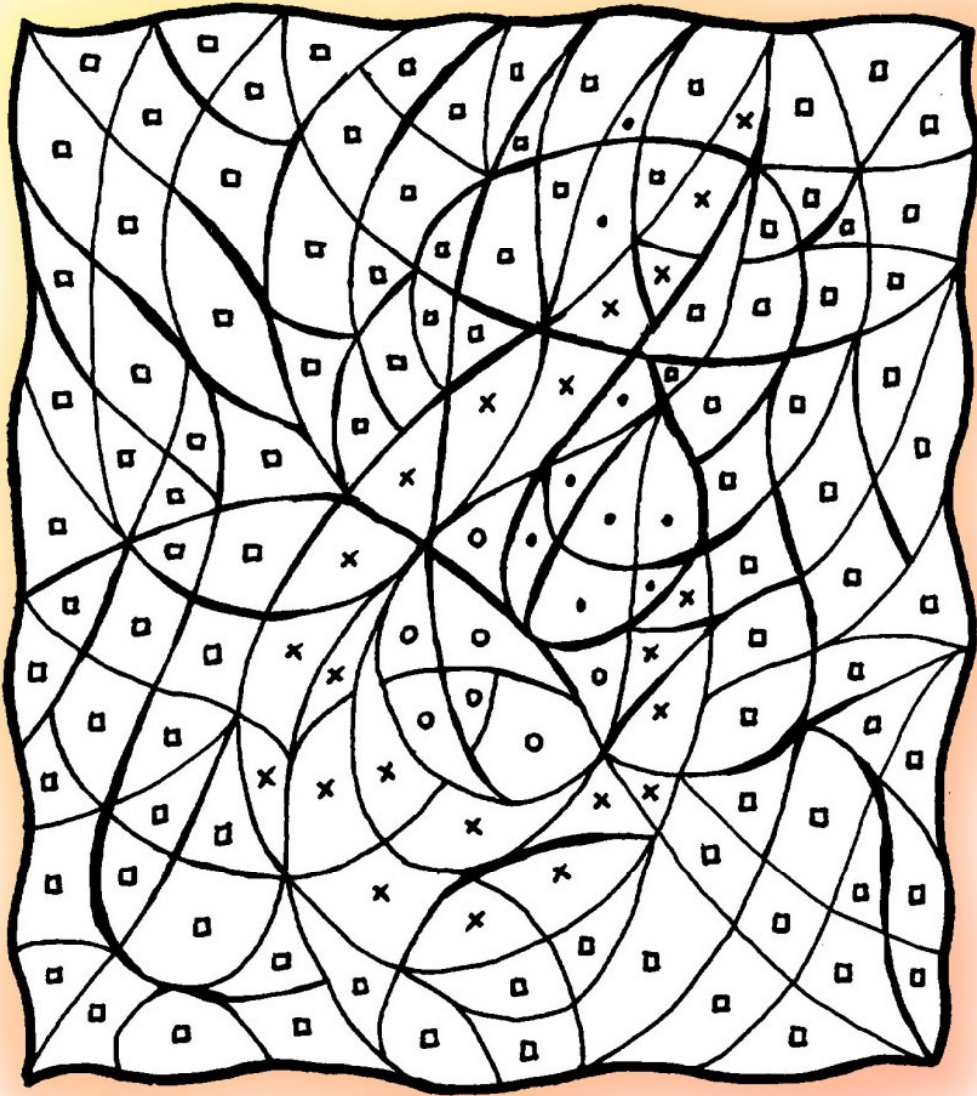
Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit as it was in the beginning, is now and will be forever! Amen.





I did not say you could give up.




You are free to travel anywhere.
